Welcome to Wakaya, your own private island. We are here to take very good care of you while helping you discover the many facets of the Wakaya experience. We invite you to relax in paradise as our staff offers suggestions and handles the details that make each day an extraordinary experience and a treasured memory.

Hiking, Jogging and Nature Walks

Early in your stay, we recommend that you explore the island with a guided Orientation Walk to give you a taste of the wild natural beauty, the mystery and the history that is Wakaya. In all, the island offers 15 miles of road-way for hiking and jogging, leading to tropical forests, white beaches and spectacular lookout points. The island's southern tip is a wildlife sanctuary rich with exotic fauna including feral horses, deer, pigs, and goat. Please make arrangements at the Reception Bure.

Scuba Diving and Snorkeling

There is no better way to discover Wakaya than by venturing into "the blue." Your room rate includes two one-tank dives per person per day and all equipment. Enhanced by the able assistance and good company of The Wakaya Club & Spa staff who call these waters home, certified scuba divers can explore more than a dozen outstanding dive sites just minutes from the Marina. For non-certified divers, we have a selection of scuba courses so you may become certified here on Wakaya. Snorkeling is excellent right in front of your bure or at any of the dive sites. Scuba and snorkeling is available Monday through Saturday and all arrangements may be made at the Reception Bure.

Fishing, Reef Viewing and Swimming

Wakaya offers fishing for everyone, from the challenge of reef casting and the tranquility of handline fishing, to the thrill of deep-sea fishing. Our Reception staff will provide information on excursions and charter rates.

Fishing excursions are available Monday through Saturday, or on Sundays with 2 days advance notice.

Wakaya is blessed with several excellent swimming beaches, the most notable being Homestead Bay. For your pleasure there is also a freshwater pool beside the Palm Grove Restaurant deck.

Golf, Tennis and Croquet

The Wakaya Club & Spa has its own 9-hole golf course, a small but challenging course with some of the holes just yards from Homestead Bay.

Our Wimbledon-Tex surfaced tennis court is lighted for play during evening hours. The Wakaya Club & Spa pro will be happy to give lessons or participate with you.

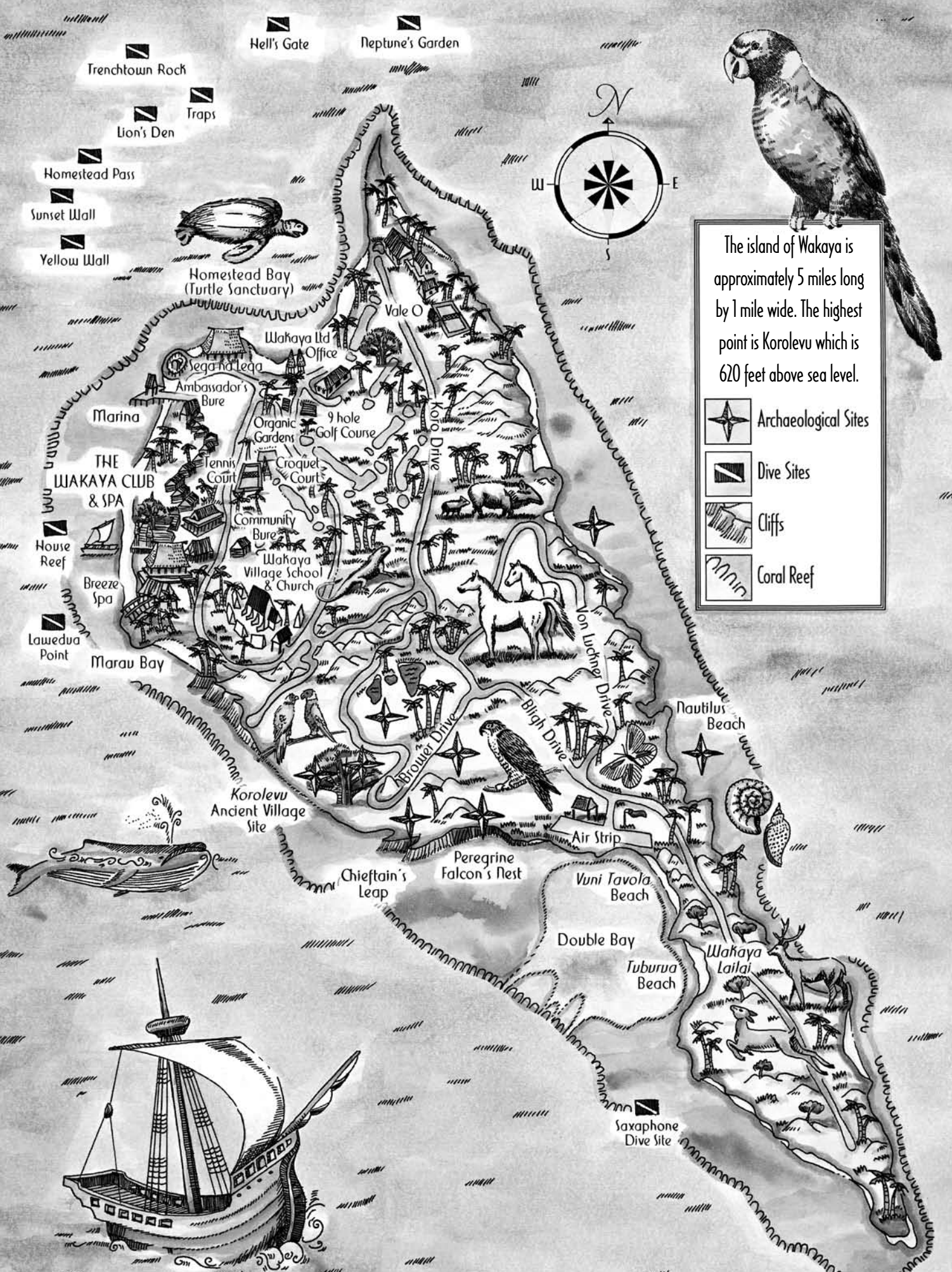
Our David Niven Croquet Court is adjacent to the tennis court. We will be happy to instruct you in the rules of the game, for your enjoyment.
